**Re: Pest control licence (Technician)**

Please find enclosed your pest control licence issued by the Department of Health under section 101(2) of the *Public Health and Wellbeing Act 2008* (technician licence).

**This licence is valid for a period of three years from the date of issue.**

The pesticides you are authorised to use in the course of your business as a pest control operator have been listed on your licence as per your application:

- *Pesticides (excluding fumigants) formulated to control pests (including birds and rodents) other than pest animals and timber pests*

You are reminded that it is an offence to use, or permit any of your employees to use, pesticides for commercial gain in Victoria without an appropriate licence. You may be prosecuted under section 99 or 109 respectively of the *Public Health and Wellbeing Act 2008* if this requirement is breached.

In addition, all pest control licenses are subject to a number of conditions. The department may also impose additional specific conditions on individual licences in some circumstances. Conditions on licence are issued in writing with the licence. Please see enclosed document titled *Conditions of Licence – Technician*. **It is an offence to breach a condition on licence.**
